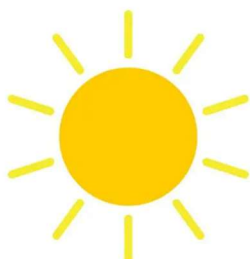
To support your child with their learning, please read the story at home and encourage your child to talk about and retell the story in their own words. Thank you.
